



LENDON GRAY SCHOLARSHIPS

Applicants must be 21 and under and have competed in the Youth Dressage Festival or participated in the Weekend Educational Program or Clinic for Pony Riders. Applicants between 21 and 23 are eligible only if they competed in the YDF or participated in the WEP or CPR within the last two years. All applicants must be actively pursuing a specific goal, and be able to demonstrate ability commensurate with stated objectives. The scholarship monies must be used for specific educational expenses that include, but are not limited to: seminars, workshops, clinics, lessons and training programs. Programs must have a stated objective, a defined beginning and end, and must be for the specific purpose of advancing the individual's horsemanship skills, knowledge or experience.

Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the individual upon submission of an application, expected educational expense budget and a signed Letter of Agreement. Any money awarded but not spent to achieve the goal outlined in the application must be returned to Dressage4Kids, Inc. Scholarship awards generally range from \$100 to \$500 but may be more generous, depending on funds available and the applicant's goals.

The Scholarship Committee expects scholarship recipients to give back to D4K programs commensurate with their knowledge and experience. By accepting scholarships, recipients must agree to volunteer their time and/or expertise in some way that will benefit or enhance D4K programs as a whole. Some ways that members give back for their scholarship awards include assisting at the YDF, WEP or CPR; conducting clinics, organizing a clinic or a fundraising event for scholarships, judging, writing an article, and/or being available for publicity, photos, etc.

All scholarship recipients will be required to write a report or story about their experience in the form of a letter, journal or diary. Photographs may be included. The report will be kept by the Committee, shared with local organizations if applicable, and may be used for publicity purposes to advance the overall awards program.

All decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.
