

THE LENDON GRAY SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS



Awards Guidelines

Scholarship moneys must be used for specific educational expenses that include, but are not limited to, seminars, workshops, clinics and training programs.

Applicants must

- have competed at the Youth Dressage Festival or participated in the Weekend Educational Program or the FEI Pony Clinic within the last two years
- be actively pursuing a specific goal
- be able to demonstrate ability commensurate with stated objectives.

Programs must

- have a stated objective
- have a defined beginning and end
- be for the specific purpose of advancing the individual's horsemanship skills, knowledge or experience.

Recipients are required to submit a written report to the Lendon Gray Scholarship Award Committee detailing their experience. The report will be shared with the Dressage4Kids, Inc. community.

Scholarship recipients range from lower level riders in training programs with local trainers to FEI-level riders participating in clinics with some of the world's most distinguished trainer/riders, including Olympic and World Cup competitors Sue Blinks, Lendon Gray and Ulla Salzgeber and two of Germany's top trainers, Cornelia Endres and Conrad Schumacher.
