Division championships feature a three-phased competition: a written test, an individual dressage test, and a group equitation ride. Divisions offered are Training through Fourth, FEI Pony, Junior and Young Rider and Para Equestrian. Riders may also assemble teams and vie for the USDF Region 8 Youth Team Championships. The FEI CanAm Concours is a team competition for FEI level riders. Also offered are a Lead line Class (riders aged 4 to 8), a Prix Caprilli class (dressage ride incorporating jumps) a musical Freestyle, and other competitive and fun activities.
